

## Out of Control Climbfest 2023

It's that time we have been waiting for! The 3rd annual Gripstone Out of Control Climbfest and competition— Arizona's unique indoor climbing event featuring: Bouldering, Top-rope and Lead Climbing. We expect even more participants and spectators this year for an unforgettable experience that brings our community closer together. We will host an after party with games, raffles, beer and other activities to spice up the festive atmosphere. There will be a food truck, and in addition, our smoothie and coffee bar will be open for business. This year promises to be the best Climbfest yet! Women's and Men's Recreational I and II divisions will follow a 1 round Redpoint\* format. Climbers can choose any Boulder, Top-rope or Auto Belay on the scorecard. There will be NO lead climbing for Recreational divisions. Score recording will be "self-Judged." The 5

<u>The Women's and Men's Advanced and Open</u> divisions will consist of a morning Redpoint qualification round to select 5 women's and 5 men's Round 2 finalists. The climbing in the qualification round will consist of: Bouldering, Top-rope, Auto-belay and Lead Climbing. Score recording will be "Peer-Judged." Gripstone will provide a limited number of belayers. Participants previously certified by Gripstone may belay also.

The scoring for all rounds will equally weight the roped and bouldering disciplines. In the evening, the 5 finalists in each division will enter an on-sight\*\* final with both bouldering and lead climbing providing a great climbing challenge for the climbers and an exciting high energy show for spectators.

Climbfest is intended to be an event where climbers of any level from beginner to elite can come and have a great time climbing or competing. Don't hesitate to be part of the fun!

\*Redpoint format allows for participants to all climb together as a group, watch and encourage each other and exchange ideas. Generally, there is no time limit for each climb, but a time limit for each round.

\*\*On-sight format means that climbers are not allowed to watch each other climb or receive any information about the climbs before their attempt. Climbers are isolated before their turn to climb. They generally will have a time limit for boulders and a one-try limit for roped climbs.

Scorecards: Peer-judged. Round one total score taken from 5 best climbs

that <u>MUST</u> include: 2 boulders, 1 lead climb, 1 roped climb of any kind,

and the 5th climb can be any climb of choice

Expected grade ranges: V3+ to V8, 5.10 to 5.12

Those completing climbs over the Adv. upper grade limits bump to Open

#### Open Qualifier (Round 1)

8:45 am: Round 1 (Qualifier) rules meeting

9:00 am-11:45 am: Climb time: 23/4 hours

Attempt any climb

Scorecards: Peer-judged. Round 1 total score taken from 5 best climbs

that <u>MUST</u> include: 2 boulders, 1 lead climb, 1 roped climb of any kind,

and the 5th climb can be any climb of choice

Expected grade ranges: V7 and up, 5.11+ and up

11:45: Turn in scorecards

### Advanced and Open Finals (Round 2)

4:30: Isolation for ALL Finalists Opens

4:45: Isolation Closes: Absolutely NO further entry

5:00: Finals Briefing and group route preview

Immediately followed by the:

Advanced Women's and Men's final round

Open Women's and Men's final round

Finals for each division will consist of 2 boulders and 1 lead climb. There will be equal weighing between the cumulative boulder scores and the Lead climb score.
